## **Courage**

"Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

- Joshua 1:9
- Give us the strength to step out into the unknown even when it's not comfortable.
- Help us to have the courage to speak boldly to friends, neighbors, and co-workers.
- May we steward well the resources we've been given for the forward move of the Kingdom, not our own comforts.
- Grow in us God-sized dreams that are beyond our human capacity, and then give us the grace to step into them.
- Open our eyes to the way that You're working in the world around us so that we might join You in what You're already doing.
- Create in us a discontent for what's safe and ordinary and draw our hearts toward powerful Kingdom advance.

### **Holiness**
